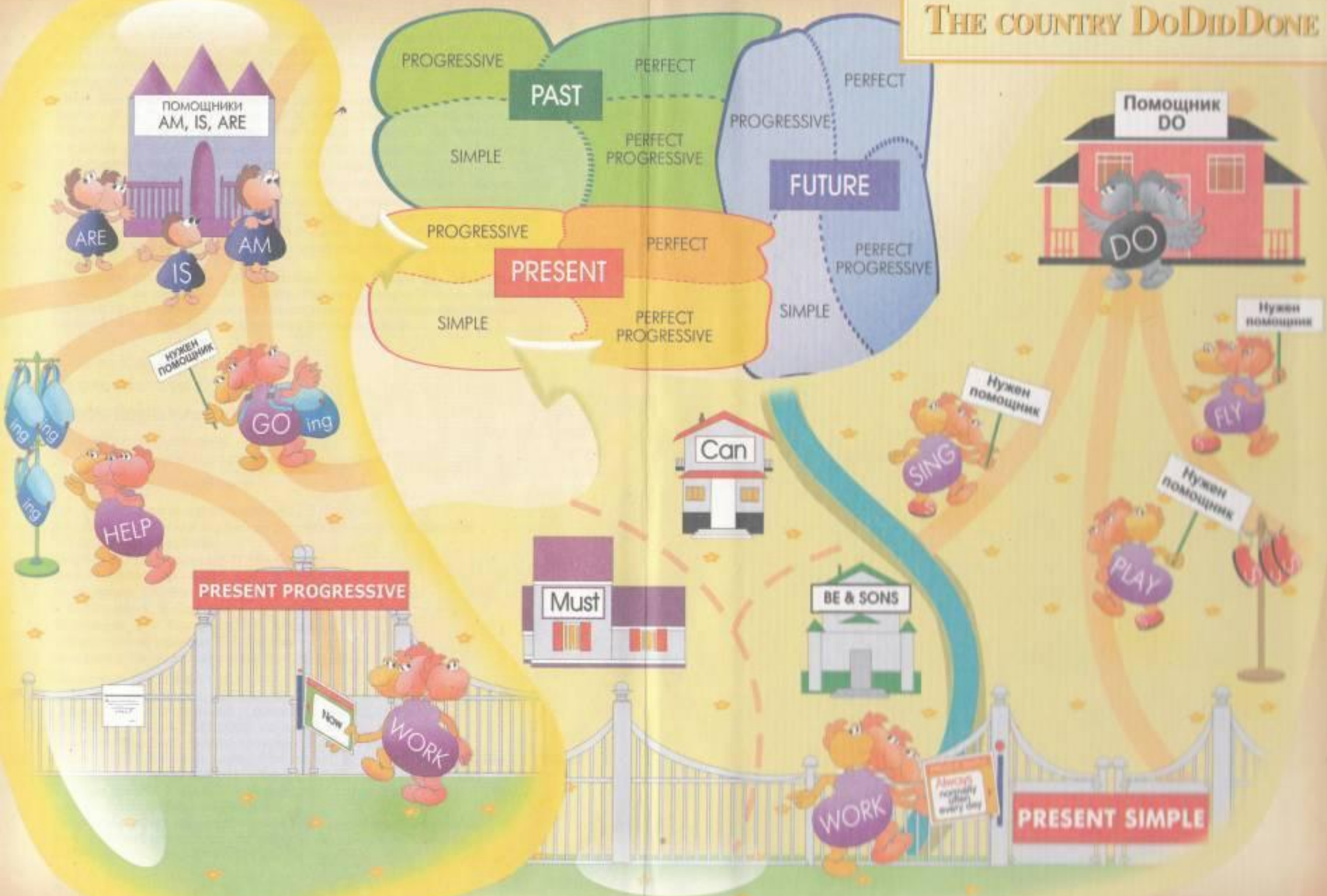

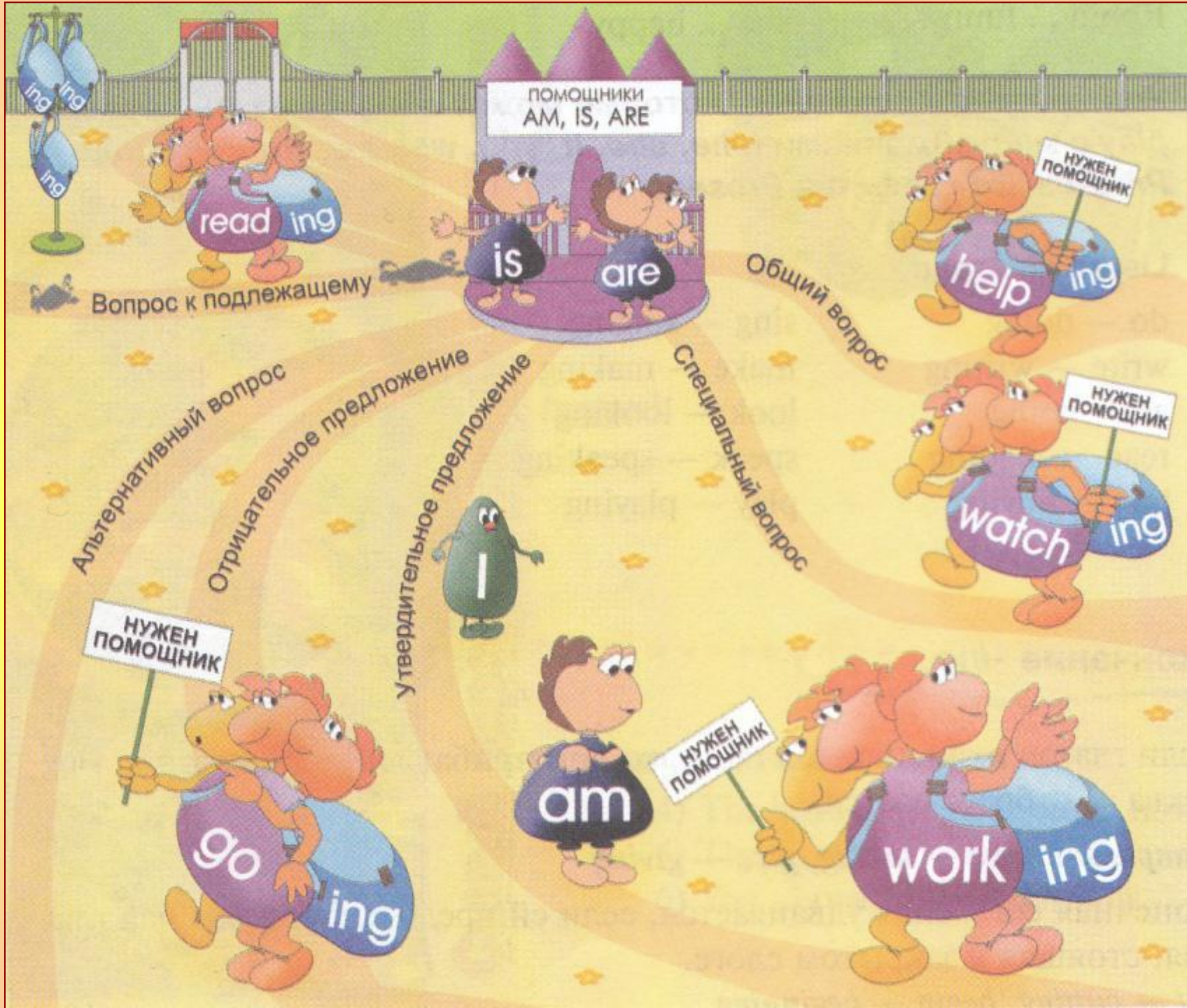

Утвердительное предложение

Подлежащее	am/is/are	Ving
------------	-----------	------

I am working - Я работаю.

You are working - Ты работаешь.

He is working - Он работает.

She is working - Она работает.

It is working - Он/Она/Оно работает.

We are working - Мы работаем.

You are working - Вы работаете.

They are working - Они работают.

take – taking, give – giving

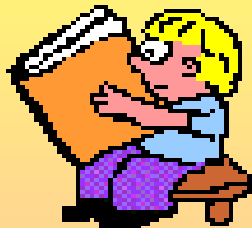
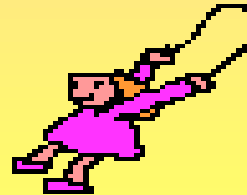
Конечная гласная удваивается, если ей предшествует ударная гласная, стоящая в закрытом слоге.
